## **Current Global Financial Crisis: A Failure of Institutions**

### Guidelines for Contributors

I-SIE expects from contributors to write around 5 to 10 pages (1000-2000 words). It should contain policy discussions and prescriptions. An article containing a small or no literature review portion is acceptable but must contain scenario analysis with logic and sufficient knowledge base as an essential component.
